# Acute Trust Reshapes its Remote Workforce to Support Better Patient Care

### *The Trust*

Worcestershire Acute Hospitals NHS Trust provides hospital-based services from the main sites of Redditch, Kidderminster, and Worcester, which serve the Worcestershire county and surrounding areas.

The Trust provides a wide range of essential services to over 580,000 people in Worcestershire and further afield with 6,000 employees and over 800 volunteers.

### *The Challenge*

One of the most pivotal challenges faced by the Trust was procuring technology that would securely offer remote access that efficiently supports the needs of both patients and clinical staff.

The Trust needed to replace an aged, out of support Microsoft Unified Access Gateway (UAG) system that would enable medical staff to complete critical activities, from viewing and updating patient records to coding clinical data without being at the hospital. Even before the UAG solution had stopped working, the Trust had not been able to rapidly deliver a solution to offer cross-departmental working and access to all data and applications.

Access to data and systems by staff and social care peers was being demanded by all departments, from midwives to radiology. Prior to finding the right solution, staff had to rely on updating patient records when they were on-site, resulting in overtime and inflexible working. This situation cost both time and money, with the risk of information being delayed due to work not being updated in real-time.

The Trust needed a robust mobile solution that would grant access to real-time data, without the fear of security or governance issues, all the while supporting their complex application mix and staff in improving patient care.

Providing mobile working into NHS Trusts can be a considerable challenge. An ageing application mix, ease of use and all aspects about privacy and security all present notable dilemmas. However, when properly implemented, **mobile working offers positive benefits to tackle increased waiting time, constant budget pressure and challenging performance measures.**



With a team of 12+ midwives, it's estimated the **Trust has saved over £20,000 in travel.**

### **The Approach**

Altiatech recommended Unify Workspace as the solution to optimise and securely streamline the workflow of the Trust's clinical and administrative staff.

### **The Outcome**

The surrounding NHS community in Worcestershire can now access the most up to date information at the point of care and record updates in real-time. With Unify Workspace empowering users to securely access data remotely, medical staff have been able to respond faster to critical requests, save time by reducing commuting and carry out administrative tasks.

The deployment of Unify Workspace delivers a secure solution that ensures all end-users and systems are fully protected. Unify Workspace reduces the opportunity for cybercrime and removes the possibility of sensitive data being taken outside the Trust's control.

With staff no longer required to travel on-site to access the hospital's network, daily commutes, travel expenses and carbon emissions were all notably reduced. Less disruption from daily commutes also led to increased productivity and staff were able to create a better worklife balance.
